The 38th Red Stag Redwoods Forest Relay is over for most people. There's the behind the scenes wrap up to be addressed – not a 5 minute job.

There was an increase in team numbers this year -97 as against 77 last year. The pleasing aspect of the entries was that there was 39 teams entered in the event's youth grade. Unfortunately 4 teams withdrew at the last minute (one school because of road /weather conditions). This leaving 35 youth teams to face the starter — a mix of club and secondary schools (18) teams. Locally Rotorua Lakes High had 5 teams taking part and it was pleasing to see that they were the randomly drawn winners of the Secondary Schools prize.

Like all club promoted events volunteers are needed and once again club members stepped to fill the role when called upon. Thank you to all who assisted.

- **2.** Members are only eligible to win championship places in their own grades, <u>and must be a paid up financial member prior to the event</u> of the Lake City Athletic Club Inc.
- 3. There will be traffic on the course. We are in a residential area. All participants must take care. Run or walk within any cones on the course. Watch for vehicles backing out of driveways!
- **4**. Please arrange for a family member to count your laps.
- **5**. Plate please for afternoon tea at the Neil Hunt Park clubrooms.
- **6.** Marshalls for the course are required. This is part of the traffic management plan we have to implement. Also wanted are recorders etc at the finish line.
