Club team selection policy: Athletics New Zealand Road relay 30 September - Rotorua.

The following has been extracted from the Club's team selection policy - the full document is on the clubrooms notice board or can be found on www.lakecity.co.nz under documentation.

"3. Selection for a Road Relay team will be based purely on "Current Fitness" and participation in the following events:

- the Athletics Waikato/BOP Road Race Championships - 19 August at Tamahere
- the Lake City Athletic club Road Race Championships
- the Red Stag Redwoods Forest Relay"

Red Stag Redwoods Forest Relay:

Saturday 9 September – This is the day of the club's annual Red Stag Redwoods Forest Relay. At the Neil Hunt Park clubrooms are lists to indicate if you desire to be a member of a club team as a runner or walker. There is also a list for you to indicate if you can be a volunteer this day. Volunteers from the club are required to make the event happen – in the region of 30. Duties are marshalling out on the course, at the start /finish area, course set up etc. A new feature to the event is that each participant will be carrying a relay baton with a timing chip inserted on it.

This Saturday 12 August – This is the afternoon of the third event in the Mokopuna Dash series. Course: 400 Raynes Road, Tamahere, Hamilton. Head thru Cambridge towards Hamilton and at Tamahere take the road to Hamilton airport. Cross the concrete bridge and up the hill to Raynes Road on the right. The course is approx. 350 metres down Raynes Road, off to the right. Parking is located both sides of the road as you approach the course. Traffic may be on the course so care to be taken and marshalls must be obeyed.

Eligibility: to be eligible for an Athletics Waikato BOP championship placing athletes (including master's grades) must be registered as a competitive athlete with AWBOP. Social registered and non registered (unaffiliated) athletes may compete but are ineligible for AWBOP championship placing or medals. **Child athletes note that you must have registered for the new season starting 1 April 2017 to be eligible for the Championships. Your previous summer membership from last season has now expired.**

Ages: Masters is age on the day: all other grades ages as at 31 December 2017. Where races are combined the grades will be separated in the results

Entry closing: Entry can be made online by the **14 August** to <https://2017awboproad.eventsdesq.com/> or posted to AWBOP Administrator P O Box 46 Hamilton with: first name and surname, Club (Lake City Rotorua), Age group, Date of birth, Fee paid, Registered –yes/no. Cheques to be payable to Athletics Waikato BOP. Entry after 14 July and on the day will be an extra \$5.00 per person. Entry forms at the Neil Hunt Park clubrooms.

All club members should note this is one of the events the club selectors are looking at the performances of those who have placed their name on the Athletics NZ relay list at the Neil Hunt Park clubrooms.

ANZ Road championships: The AWBOP team to the National road championships in Christchurch on Saturday 2 September will be selected from those entered at close of the championship entries. Athletes must enter themselves via www.athletics.org.nz before entry closing date and be a competitive member of the Lake City Athletic Club. The early entry closing date is **Wednesday 24 August 11.59pm**. Late entry after the 24th and up to Monday 28 August 9.00am is an extra \$50.00

Sunday 27 August - Cambridge Half Marathon - - The event doubles as the Athletics Waikato BOP half marathon championships. Entry can be made by visiting <http://www.sporty.co.nz.cahcnz> or www.cambridgeharriers.co.nz

Volunteers: with the annual Red Stag Forest relay coming up on the 9 September volunteers from the Club are required to marshal, mark the course etc. This is as well as club members running or walking the event. As from the weekend there will be lists at the clubrooms to indicate your availability either a volunteer or participant, or both. Make sure you are placing your name on the correct list(s). In due course there will be a list at the clubrooms relating to volunteers at the Athletic New Zealand Road relay on 30 September
