*Course*: 400 Raynes Road, Tamahere, Hamilton. Head thru Cambridge towards Hamilton and at

Tamahere take the road to Hamilton airport. Cross the concrete bridge and up the hill to Raynes Road on the right. The course is approx. 350 metres down Raynes Road, off to the right. Parking is located both sides of the road as you approach the course. Traffic may be on the course – care to be taken and marshalls must be obeyed.

**Eligibility:** to be eligible for an Athletics Waikato BOP championship placing athletes (including master's grades) must be registered as a competitive athlete with AWBOP. Social registered and non registered (unaffiliated) athletes may compete but are ineligible for AWBOP championship placing or medals. **Child athletes note that you must have registered for the new season starting 1 April 2017 to be eligible for the Championships. Your previous summer membership from last season has now expired.** 

**Ages:** Masters is age on the day: all other grades ages as at 31 December 2017. Where races are combined the grades will be separated in the results **Entry closing:** Entry can be made online by **14 August** to <a href="https://2017awboproad.eventsdesq.com/">https://2017awboproad.eventsdesq.com/</a> or posted to AWBOP Administrator P O Box 46 Hamilton with: first name and surname, Club (Lake City Rotorua), Age group, Date of birth, Fee paid, Registered —yes/no. Cheques payable to Athletics Waikato BOP. Entry after 14 July and on the day will be an extra \$5.00 per person. Entry forms at the Neil Hunt Park clubrooms.

All club members should note this is one of the events the club selectors are looking at the performances of those who have placed their name on the Athletics NZ relay list at the Neil Hunt Park clubrooms.

**Lake City walkers** – There will be a 5km non championship event on this day for walkers. This event will be combined with the 1.00pm events. Costs: \$5.00 early entry by 14 July and another \$5.00 after the 14th.
