The first report is of the local event on Saturday this from the winter season's convener, Matt Thanks to everyone who came out to Lake Okareka for the Pairs Handicap Race. We had 9 pairs who did the 4.2km pairs handicap run, and all 9 teams finished within 2 minutes! Congratulations to Matthew Gear and Colin Earwaker for being the first team back. There was also a 2.5km run for the children, which was won by Keira Murphy. Thanks to everyone who came along. A big thank you is extended to Rachel for doing the results, which are below.

Secondly out of Rotorua at Grenada Park North (Wellington) was the Athletics New Zealand crosscountry championships. The small contingent from the club performed creditably on a course that got muddier as the events went on. First up was Hannah Gapes who ran a will judged race working her way through the field for 6th overall in her under 18 4000 metres and to be a member her grades Waikato winning team – her first Athletics NZ gold medal. Tony Broadhead (50-54 – 8000 metres) and Trevor Ogilvie (70-74 – 6000 meters) both came home with golds and Kathy Howard took out the silver medal in her 65-69 - 6000 metres. Both Trevor and Kathy ran in the last event therefore having the worse underfoot conditions of the day.

Supporting their fellow club members were Jason Cameron (9th men 45-49 - 8000 metres) and Graeme Adams (8th men 65-59 - 6000 metres).

Youngest Jonah Funnell, wore the club colours in the second to last race to finish 22nd overall in the boys under 11 2000 metres thus gaining valuable experience running in a field of 33.
