Athletics Waikato BOP winter season

• The Athletics Waikato BOP cross-country champs - Saturday 1 August will take place at Waipuna Park, Kaitemako Road, Welcome Bay, Tauranga. Prizegiving will be at the venue at approx.3.45pm. Entry can be made online by visiting AWBOP website. Closing date for online entry is Wednesday 29 July. On the day entry is available but with a \$5.00 late entry fee.

Ages: Most age grades are as at 31 December 2020, e.g. for under 14 you must be 12 or 13 on 31 December 2020. Master age grades are age on the day. Where races are combined the grades will be separated in the results

Eligibility: To be eligibility for an AWBOP championship place athlete (including masters grades) must be a competitive registered athlete with AWBOP. Social and non-registered (unaffiliated) athletes may compete but are ineligible for AWBOP championship placings or medals. Child athletes please note that you must have registered for the new season starting 1 April 2020 to be eligible for the championships. Your previous summer membership from 2019/20 season has expired.
